Case Review Introduction

The Greater Cleveland Brain Injury Coalition (BIC) was founded to identify services and service gaps centering on the needs of survivors of brain injury. These meetings have served as the inter-agency link between the service providers for comprehensive planning and problem-solving. In September of 1996, the BIC began case reviews to provide advice and guidance in an attempt to empower survivors of traumatic brain injury, and their families, to identify and access comprehensive, quality services.

If you are interested in presenting a case review at a meeting, please complete the case review form. When completing the form, please be certain to refer to the client by their initials only. Your case will be scheduled for one half hour. Please be prepared to present a brief overview of the case including the injury, medical status, course of rehabilitation, current issues/barriers at hand and community agencies involved. This should take approximately 5-10 minutes. Please plan to use the BIC Case Review form to structure your presentation. The remainder of time will be spent problem solving with the committee. In addition, you are responsible for completing and forwarding the Informed Consent/Release of Information form and communicating the meeting time and place to the family and survivor.
